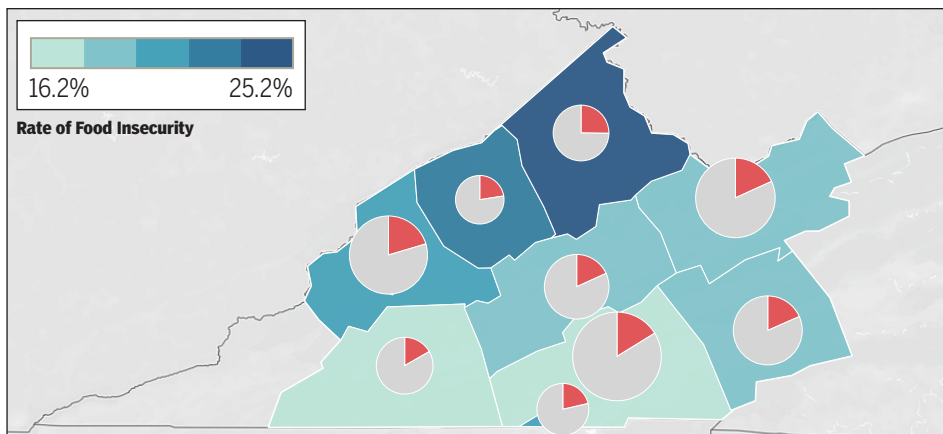
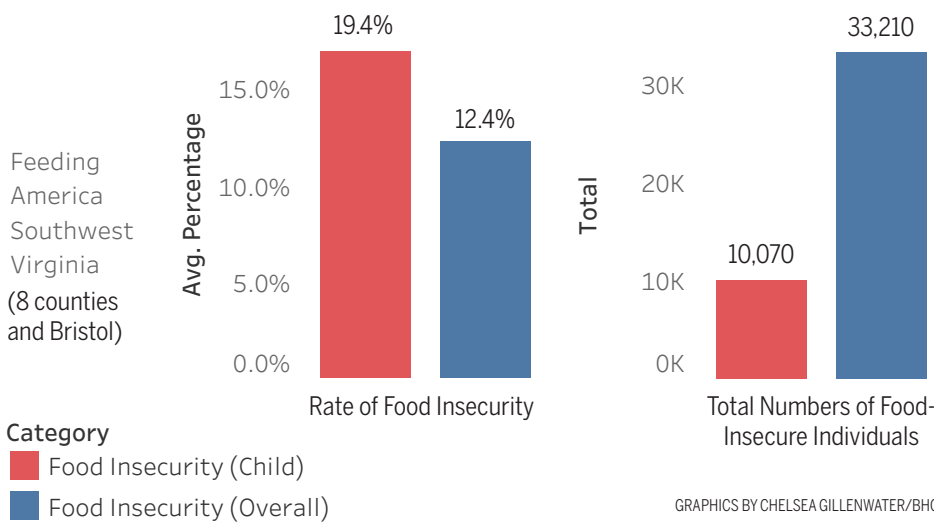


Food Insecurity in Southwest Virginia Among Children



The red wedges show the percentage of children in each county who are labeled “food insecure,” and the size of each pie graph shows the total population of food-insecure children in each county. The bar charts below show that children are at greater risk of being food insecure compared to the overall population.
