V. BOARD APPOINTMENT

- A. It is ordered that Greg Woodruff is appointed to the Senior Citizens Board for a term ending June 30, 2028.

VI. COURT ORDERS

A. Tabled from July 27, 2026 Meeting:

- It is hereby ordered that the McCracken County Fiscal Court approve the Website Modernization Proposal Option #2 with Thicket Studio for a new McCracken County Website in the amount of \$39,000.00. It is further ordered that the Judge Executive be authorized to enter into a contract and sign all necessary documents for same; and the Treasurer be authorized to pay invoices.
- B. It is ordered that the Judge Executive is authorized to sign a service agreement with Sprocket for \$176,500.00 that was approved in the Fiscal Year 26/27 budget. It is further ordered that the treasurer is authorized to pay invoices related to the same.
- C. It is hereby ordered that A&K Construction Change Order Number 007C, as shown on the attached document and dated August 13, 2026, be approved. In summary, the change order provides for a \$476,506.00 reduction to the contract. The new A&K Construction amount will be \$50,460,284.92. Contract change includes a \$476,506.00 credit for the direct purchase of five pavilions from Recreation Insights. It is further ordered that the Treasurer is authorized to pay invoices related to the same.
- D. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated July 13, 2026, to BFW for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$9,987.11. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- E. It is ordered to pay the invoices dated June 22, 2026, and August 5, 2026, to Troutman Sign Graphics for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$15,100.00. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- F. It is ordered to approve July 2026 Transient Room Tax in the amount of \$519,492.74 be disbursed as follows:

- G. It is ordered that \$10,000.00 be paid to Mercy Regional Ambulance Service for reimbursement of FY 26-27 KBEMS Block Grant.
- H. It is ordered to pay the invoice dated July 30, 2026, to Uline for the Sports Complex Project, in the amount of \$1,379.18. This is pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement dated September 7, 2022, between the City of Paducah, Kentucky, the County of McCracken County, Kentucky, and the Sports Tourism Commission. As per the Interlocal Agreement, the City of Paducah pays half of the invoice to McCracken County.
- I. It is ordered that the Fiscal Court enter into a maintenance agreement with Paducah Blueprint to furnish full maintenance service on the HP DJXL3600 printer located in the McCracken County Clerk's Office.
- J. It is ordered that Contractor's Application and Certificate for Payment No. 1 in the amount of \$99,299.37 be paid to Ascendant Facility Partners, LLC. for the Convention and Expo Center project.
- K. It is ordered that the following equipment previously used by McCracken County is declared as surplus to be sold at a future auction.

**MCCRACKEN COUNTY FISCAL COURT ORDER
ACCEPTING TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY AND
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF TRANSFER
DOCUMENTS**

WHEREAS, McCracken County (the "County"), has been offered a transfer of parcels of real property, at no cost, by deed from the McCracken County Sports Tourism Agency;
and

WHEREAS, the County desires to accept the transfer of the real property described below; and

WHEREAS, the County will enter a ground lease to lease the property back to the McCracken County Sports Tourism Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the McCracken County Fiscal Court as follows:

Acceptance of Property. The McCracken County Fiscal Court hereby accepts the transfer by deed, at no cost to the County, of the following parcels of real property located in McCracken County, Kentucky:

- a. Parcel I: 130 Metcalf Lane
- b. Parcel II: 142 Metcalf Lane
- c. Parcel III: 134 Metcalf Lane

Authorization to Execute Documents. The McCracken County Fiscal Court hereby authorizes Deputy Judge Executive Steve Ervin to execute the deed and any other transfer documents related hereto, and to take such further actions as are reasonably necessary to carry out the intent of this Order.

Effective Date. This Order shall be effective upon passage by the McCracken County Fiscal Court at a duly called meeting.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-13

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY MCCRACKEN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05, SETTING FORTH THE PREVIOUS FORM OF THE MCCRACKEN COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND ENACTING A REPLACEMENT ADMINISTRATIVE CODE CONTAINING ALL AMENDMENTS ENACTED SUBSEQUENT TO THE INITIAL PASSAGE OF MCCRACKEN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05.

Summary: The present action is mandated by KRS 67.710 and KRS 68.005 and operates to repeal in its entirety the current McCracken County Administrative Code as previously enacted by Ordinance 2024-05 and containing the amendments enacted subsequently to its initial passage. The present action allows the full incorporation of all such subsequent amendments into a single self-contained code for ease of administration and more effective and efficient notice of and compliance with its provisions
