

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT

DELTA-8 THC

Delta 8 THC is new, potentially harmful drug that is made from the cannabis plant. It is a psychoactive drug, which means that it affects how the brain works. It can cause changes in mood, awareness, thoughts, feelings, or behavior.

This product is being sold online and also in local stores in different forms, like brownies, candy and gummies. This product has not been researched by the FDA to determine if it is safe.

Delta-8 THC is not approved or regulated by the FDA. Products may have false or misleading marketing.

- Products may claim to have therapeutic or medicinal benefits. This can put someone at risk, because the product has not been proven to be safe.
- The product may be labeled as “hemp”. This could mislead someone to think it is not a psychoactive drug.
- The product may include other chemicals or cannabinoids (substances found in cannabis) that are not written on the label.
- The label may not say how much Delta-8 THC, if any, is in the product.

Delta-8 THC products may contain harmful chemicals.

- Manufacturers may use unsafe household chemicals to make Delta-8 THC.
- Other chemicals may be used to change the color of the final product.
- Since Delta-8 THC is unregulated, the products may be made in uncontrolled or unsanitary settings.

Delta-8 THC may have negative health effects.

- Delta-8 THC has psychoactive and intoxicating effects, similar to the “high” people may feel from using cannabis.
- Over the last year, the FDA has reported people having adverse events from Delta-8 THC. These adverse events included vomiting, hallucinations, trouble standing, and loss of consciousness. Some of these people had to be hospitalized.
