

### ELECTION CORNER

**COVID-19 Reminders:** Due to social distancing requirements and public health orders, in-person voting for both absentee and Election Day will have limited capacity and potentially take longer. We ask that voters consider getting a ballot by mail or be prepared to be patient as staff and poll workers get voters in and out as safely as possible.

### REGISTER TO VOTE

Often times we see voters wait until Election Day to register to vote, only to find they do not have acceptable proof of residence documents, or they do not meet the residency requirements to vote in the Village.

- Check your voter registration status now to make sure you are registered to vote in advance of the Election by visiting: [myvote.wi.gov/MyVoterInfo](http://myvote.wi.gov/MyVoterInfo), or contact the Clerk's office at 608-838-3153.
- If you are not registered to vote at your current address or with your current name, you can begin the process online until October 14, 2020 at [myvote.wi.gov/RegisterToVote](http://myvote.wi.gov/RegisterToVote).
  - As long as your address matches what is in the WI DMV's system, you will be able to fully complete your registration at this website.
  - If your address does not match, you can update your address with the WI DMV by visiting: [trust.dot.state.wi.us/dmvac/dmvacservlet?whoami=search](http://trust.dot.state.wi.us/dmvac/dmvacservlet?whoami=search). Then go back and register to vote through MyVote Wisconsin.

After October 14, 2020, registration must occur in the Clerk's Office or on Election Day, unless an elector is hospitalized or military. You will need to provide proof of residence with current name/address.

Due to new election law, you must have resided in the jurisdiction you are voting in within 28 days of the election. Be mindful of this as you determine where you will vote on Election Day.

### DON'T FORGET YOUR PHOTO ID

Not a new topic, but a photo ID is required for the upcoming Election. For a full list of acceptable Photo IDs and information on how to get a free ID card for voting if you do not have one visit:

### PROOF OF RESIDENCE COMMON FORMS INCLUDE:

- WI Driver's License
- WI ID Card
- Utility Bill
- Bank Statement
- Lease

### COMMON FORMS OF PHOTO IDS INCLUDE:

- WI DOT issued driver's license
- WI DOT issued ID card
- U.S. Passport
- Military ID card issued by a U.S. uniformed service
