## Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) Processing Applications Year Round

West Ohio CAP continues to process enrollment and re-verification applications for the PIPP Plus Program. PIPP Plus helps you manage your energy bills by making monthly utility payments more affordable, allowing you to make consistent monthly payments based on a percentage of your household income.

Households that have utility service from an electric or natural gas company regulated by the Public Utility Commission of Ohio, with income at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines are eligible for this program. Homeowners and renters alike are eligible for this assistance!

When determining 175% of the FPG, households with more than 8 members must add \$8,995 to the yearly income or \$739.31 to the 30-day income for each additional member.
