- 4. Complete a Clean Up Application and return it to the City of Lima Department of Housing and Neighborhoods by Monday, April 26th, 2024

The City of Lima will provide trash bags, t-shirts, and loan tools to any neighborhood or community organization that will staff a community service project during the Mayor's Spring Clean Up Saturdays.

- 1. Choose a Saturday that works best for your organization
- 2. Select a service project and location
- 3. Recruit volunteers
- 4. Complete a **Clean Up Application** and return it to the City of Lima Department of Housing and Neighborhoods by Monday,
