The Swanson for Mayor Campaign is concerned with the circumstances of the incident on February 20th. En route to a friend's house, Ms. Swanson pulled off the side of the road to use her phone, at which time her vehicle became stuck in the snow. Ms. Swanson reached out to friends for assistance in extricating her car. While she awaited assistance, an officer stopped to investigate the situation and requested various sobriety tests. When Ms. Swanson requested that she be allowed to wait for her friends to arrive to assist her, she was taken into custody by the officer. While the circumstances of this incident are pending legal review, the Swanson Campaign stands firmly behind Autumn Swanson's candidacy for mayor and will provide more information as we review with legal counsel. Neither Ms. Swanson, her vehicle, nor anyone else was injured or damaged.
