ZACHARY L. LOVE did

* receive, retain or dispose of property, a black 2020 Infinity having vehicle identification number JN1FV7ELXLM460242, a motor vehicle as defined in Ohio Revised Code §4501.01, being the property of another, to-wit: Joseph Prcela, and Zachary L. Love had reasonable cause to believe said property had been obtained through the commission of a theft offense, as defined in Ohio Revised Code §2913.01;

in violation of Ohio Revised Code, Title 29 Section 2923.03(A)(2) and 2913.51(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

in violation of Ohio Revised Code, Title 29 Section 2921.12(A)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

*Set forth the offense in any words sufficient to give the defendant notice of all elements of the offense, or otherwise in proper form pursuant to Criminal Rule 7 (B).

THIRD COUNT:

THE JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of the county aforesaid, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present that on or about the 31st day of March, 2022, at Orange Township, Hancock County, Ohio

ZACHARY L. LOVE did

- * knowingly acquire, have, carry or use a firearm, to-wit: a 12 gauge Mossberg 500 shotgun, Serial Number R265281, and a 9mm Glock 17 semi-automatic pistol, Serial Number BNSC654, without first having been relieved from disability as provided in §2923.14 of the Ohio Revised Code, and said Zachary L. Love, has previously been adjudicated a delinquent child for the commission of an offense that if committed by an adult, would have been a felony offense of violence, to-wit: Aggravated Robbery [F1], a felony of the first degree, in Franklin County Juvenile Court Case Number 18JU004503;

in violation of Ohio Revised Code, Title 29 Section 2923.13(A)(2) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

*Set forth the offense in any words sufficient to give the defendant notice of all elements of the offense, or otherwise in proper form pursuant to Criminal Rule 7 (B).

FOURTH COUNT:

ZACHARY L. LOVE did

- * knowingly transport or have a loaded firearm, as defined in Ohio Revised Code §2923.11, to-wit: a 12 gauge Mossberg 500 shotgun, Serial Number R265281 and a 9mm Beretta semi-automatic pistol, Serial Number NU021480, in a motor vehicle, in such a manner that the firearm is accessible to the operator or passenger without leaving the vehicle;

in violation of Ohio Revised Code, Title 29 Section 2923.16(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.


