CITY OF INTERNATIONAL FALLS MAYORAL PROCLAMATION IN RESPECTFUL OBSERVANCE OF

VIETNAM VETERANS DAY

WHEREAS, on March 29, 1973, the last American troops were withdrawn from South Vietnam ending the Vietnam War, and

WHEREAS, eighteen (18) Koochiching County military personnel died in the Vietnam War, and

WHEREAS, due to the unpopularity of this war, both fallen and surviving airman, soldiers, sailors, and marines were not given the respect and gratitude they so richly deserved for serving our country, and

WHEREAS, the City of International Falls and all its residents appreciate the sacrifices of the men and women in service to our country, and

WHEREAS, it is honorable and fitting for all United States citizens to acknowledge the sacrifice of the men and women who served during the Vietnam War upon the anniversary date of the end of this war.

VIETNAM VETERANS DAY
