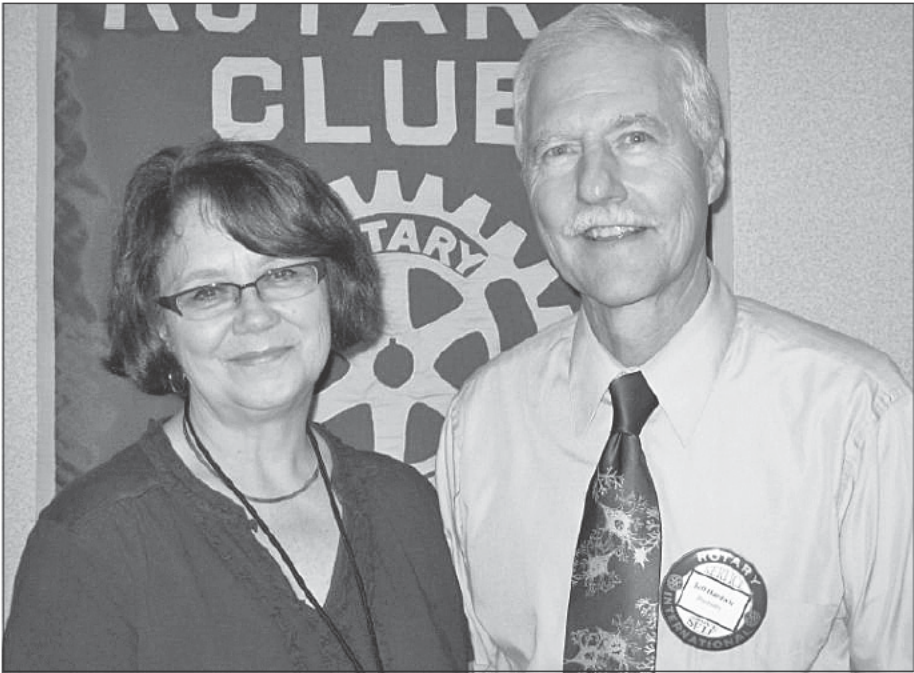

He only takes the best.*

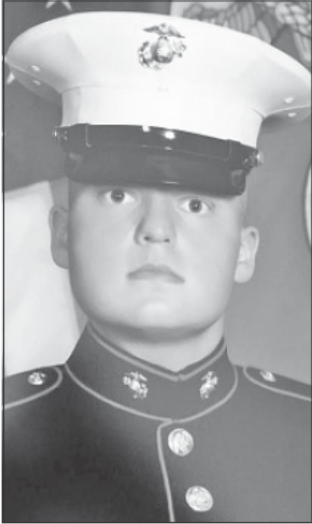
