Horse Show Results
This year's 4-H State Qualifying Horse show took place on July 7 with Tessa Drevlow as judge. Ten riders registered in Senior, Junior, Novice, and Cloverbud level classes. Throughout the show, the judge assigns a ribbon placing, and blue ribbon rankings translate into points.
