The Broncos' other two relays placed fourth with Kostiuk, Hebner, Stone and Erickson in the 4X200 (2:02.03) and Earley, Sullivan, Grace Gilbert and Stone in the 4X400 (4:39.33).

FHS BOYS 6TH

The Bronco boys were also shorthanded Friday when they didn't enter any relay events and placed sixth out of 14 teams competing in Hibbing.

The Falls ended up with 49 points. Hermantown had the top score of 138, followed by Ely (119), Hibbing (91), Eveleth-Gilbert (83) and Greenway/Nashwauk-Keewatin (54) in the top five.

Broncos junior Ethan Phung accounted for 13 points when he placed runner-up in the triple jump (38-11.25) and fourth in the long jump (18-0).

Falls senior Cole Tatsak added 10 points by finishing second in the 300 hurdles (45.88) and seventh in the 200 dash (25.12).

"Even though we only brought seven kids to the meet, the team had a pretty good meet and, as always, I'm proud of everyone on the team," Tatsak said.

Jared Hunter also picked up 10 points by placing fourth in the 110 hurdles (19.33), fifth in the 300 hurdles (48.7) and eighth in the triple jump (33-3.25).

The Falls' other top-five finishes came from freshman John Cowman, who placed third in the 400 dash (56.84), and junior Wyatt Helgeson, who ended up fourth in the pole vault (10-6).

Two other Bronco boys placed in the top eight to score points. Senior Gary Harala finished sixth in the discus (113-1) and freshman Tanner Budris came in seventh in the 400 dash (58.18).

The Falls will be back in Hibbing today for the North Sub-Section 7A Meet.
