DISTRICT COURT

The following people have been sentenced for aggravated misdemeanor or felony crimes in Koochiching County District Court. This information is provided to The Journal by court staff.

■ Aaron E. D. Meyer, 24, International Falls, was sentenced Oct. 21 for felony terrorist threats — reckless disregard of risk. He was sentenced to 18 months at the Minnesota Correctional Facility, St. Cloud, which was stayed on court conditions, and was placed on supervised probation for five years. He was ordered to 30 days local confinement and ordered to serve 24 hours with the Sentence to Serve program. He was ordered to pay \$225 of fine and fees and must supply a DNA sample to the state. He was ordered to write a letter of apology and follow the recommendations of an evaluation. He may not use alcohol or drugs and may not enter places where it is sold. He must submit to random testing and searches.

■ Amanda N. Baron, 25, International Falls, was sentenced Nov. 18 for two counts of felony fifth-degree

drugs — possess, procure, control by fraud or deceit. On the first count, she was sentenced to one year and one day at the Minnesota Correctional Facility, Shakopee, which was stayed on court conditions. She was placed on five years supervised probation and ordered to follow the recommendations of a chemical assessment. She was ordered to pay \$150 fine and fees and serve 40 hours with the Sentence to Serve program. She may not use alcohol or drugs or enter places where it is being served or used.

She must submit to random testing and searches and may not use or possess firearms or dangerous weapons. The sentence for the second count is to run concurrently with the previous sentence. She was sentenced to 13 months at the Shakopee facility, which was stayed, and she was placed on five years supervised probation. The previous conditions were also set on this count.

■ Jarrod H. Donnell, 24, International Falls, was sentenced Nov. 18 for felony financial transaction card fraud — use without con-

sent and felony counterfeiting of currency — uttering or possession. On the fraud, he was sentenced to 13 months at the Minnesota Correctional Facility, St. Cloud, and placed on five years supervised probation. He was ordered to serve 12 months in the local jail and pay \$200 fine and fees and \$606 restitution. He was ordered to complete a chemical assessment and may not use alcohol or drugs or enter places where it is being used or served. He must submit to random tests. The sentence on the counterfeiting is to run concurrently with the previous sentence. He was sentenced to 13 months at the St. Cloud facility, which was stayed, and he was ordered to 12 months local confinement. He was ordered to pay \$75 in fees and the previous conditions were also set on this count.

■ Thomas J. Stocki, 29, Wauwtosa, Wis., was sentenced Nov. 18 for felony fifth-degree drugs — possession. He was given a stay of adjudication and placed on five years probation. He was ordered to pay \$1,500 in fees.
