Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve minutes of the regular city council meeting of January 6, 2014. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.  
Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve transfer from Water and Sewer fund 601 for administrative costs to General fund 101 in the amount of \$16,492.00. Motion seconded by Councilor Rognerud and carried unanimously.  
Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve transfer from Water and Sewer fund 601 for capital outlay projects to Reserve for Capital Outlay fund 403 in the amount of \$15,958.50. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.  
Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve payment of claims from various funds of the city including checks 52295-52419 with the exception of the CGMC claim in the amount of \$10,004- as per Mayor Anderson's request. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

under blanket authorization in the amount of \$85,650.30.
