Read to the early readers in your life

School has been out for a month, that initial enthusiasm or willingness to practice and keep reading may be fading. Encourage the children in your life to keep reading. And don't forget to read to the pre and early readers in your life. Hearing stories and books read is one of the best ways to help children be good readers themselves.

Here are three new books to share with a special someone in a quiet moment (or not as you laugh at the antics in two of the three).

The Matchbox Diary by Paul Fleischman is a beautiful story of a young girl visiting her great-grandfather. He asks her to select something and he'll tell her the story behind it. She picks a cigar box which ends up holding many stories as inside the box are matchboxes, each with a small momento of an event in his life.

Find a Cow Now! by Janet Stevens and Susan Stevens Crummel is a hilarious look at what happens when a city dog listens to a parrot after he gets tired of always napping. As the title suggests, Dog sets off to find a cow, even though he doesn't know what that is.

We are all at least a little odd, that is what makes us unique. But what if we don't know we are odd. *Odd Duck* by Cecil Castellucci and Sara Varon is a delightful, laugh out loud story of Theodora and Chad, two ducks who on the surface at least don't have much in common, especially as Theodora thinks she is being a good model of 'duckness' for Chad.
