A regular meeting of the City Council of International Falls, Minnesota, was held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on the 5th day of August 2013 at the hour of 4:30 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Councilors Eklund, Jaksa, Kalar, Rognerud and Mayor Anderson
MEMBERS ABSENT: none

Mayor Anderson opened the public hearing at 4:00 PM regarding special assessments for the Aspen Way project, describing the project and providing the council with estimates of specific special assessments for property owners. He stated that the city has received written responses from six of the seven effected property owners and five of the seven are in support of assessments paying for the project. Mayor Anderson requested input from the audience and no comments were received. Mayor Anderson closed the public hearing at 4:15 PM.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve minutes of the regular city council meeting of July 15, 2013. Motion seconded by Councilor Rognerud and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve minutes of the special city

council meeting of July 22, 2013. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve transfer of Lodging Tax in the amount of \$1,071.43 to Fund 101. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Eklund to approve payment of claims from various funds of the city including checks 50999-51124 in the amount of \$518,796.96. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Checks 97484-97499 were issued under blanket authorization in the amount of \$85,283.18.

Bob Walls representing the International Falls Co-Ed Softball League presented information and requested use of the Kerry Park Softball fields for their 4th Annual Fight for a Cure Softball Tournament scheduled for August 16-18, 2013. Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve use of Kerry Park Softball Fields for the International Falls Co-Ed Softball Fight for a Cure tournament. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Mike Holden representing the Koochiching Labor Assembly asked the city to co-sponsor the 3rd Annual Community Labor Day Picnic scheduled for September 2, 2013 from 4-7pm at Smokey Bear Park. Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve co-sponsoring with Koochiching Labor Assembly the Community Labor Day Picnic to include advertisements, use of picnic tables, trash receptacles w/liners, and barricades. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve subordination to TruStar Federal Credit Union the following: Revolving Loan Mortgage SCDP Com-

mercial Rehabilitation Program and Deferred Repayment Loan Agreement SCDP Commercial Rehabilitation Program for Donald and Sally Chowan as presented by Kimberly A. Litovich, Shermoen & Jaksa, PLLP. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve supporting the Heart of the Continent Partnership and National Geographic Geo-tourism Project with a donation of \$2500 for its marketing and educational efforts. Motion seconded by Councilor Rognerud and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to remove the approval requirement of budgeted travel and training items-travel and training items not budgeted and/or over expenditure of the annual travel and training budget requires council approval. Motion seconded by Councilor Rognerud and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve publication of the 100th Season of International Falls Bronco Football, 2013 Football Season. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Kalar to begin the process of selling timber from city owned property located at the east end of the Van Lynn Road. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve Kerry Park Arena Lease Agreement with Rainy Lake Sport Fishing Club for their annual Senior Fish Fry scheduled for September 8, 2013. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Eklund to adopt Resolution #29-13 authorizing to execute MnDOT grant agreement for airport maintenance and operations. Motion seconded by

Councilor Rognerud and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to adopt Resolution #30-13 inviting Canadian Ambassador to the United States the Honorable Gary Doer to visit the two communities and that the City of International Falls would share in the cost, not to exceed \$1000, for a meal associated with the presentation. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to adopt Resolution #31-13 requesting that the Federal Aviation Administration grant a waiver to the International Falls Airport Commission allowing our airport to continue operating with undeputized security. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to adopt Resolution #32-13 requesting that the State of Minnesota include \$3,000,000 in funding from the State of Minnesota Bonds Issued in 2014. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to approve making application to the Department of Employment and Economic Development for "Shovel-Ready" certification of the Multi-Modal Facility District. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar. Councilor Jaksa asked whether the "City" or the "City EDA" should be seeking the certification. Mayor Anderson stated that the T.E.D. Grant is the "City's". After further discussion, Councilor Rognerud withdrew her motion. No further action was taken.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to begin the process of Joint Orderly Annexation for annexation of the Multi-Modal Facility District property, approximately 52 acres, into the City of International Falls. Motion

seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to reconsider the motion of July 15, 2013 council meeting "not moving forward with the preliminary survey of the Donahue Property wetlands". Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa. Voting on the motion aye: Eklund, Kalar, Rognerud, Jaksa, nay: Anderson. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to allow Dave Serrano to conduct a preliminary survey of the Donahue Property wetlands at no cost to the city. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Rognerud to move forward with the bituminous paving and curb and gutter street improvement project and assessments for the Plat of Aspen Woods-Aspen Way. Motion seconded by Councilor Eklund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Eklund to end the current hiring process for the city administrator and to notify the candidates that the process is changing and to proceed with hiring Mr. David Unmacht, Springsted, Inc., to lead the city in the hiring process of a city administrator with the cost not to exceed \$14,000. Motion seconded by Councilor Rognerud. Voting on the motion aye: Eklund, Rognerud, Jaksa, nay: Kalar, Anderson. Motion carried.
