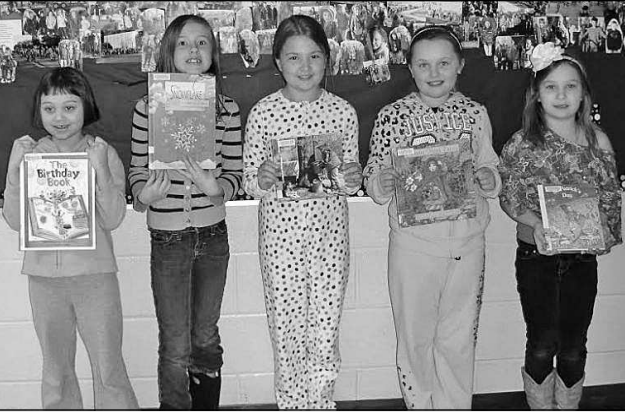


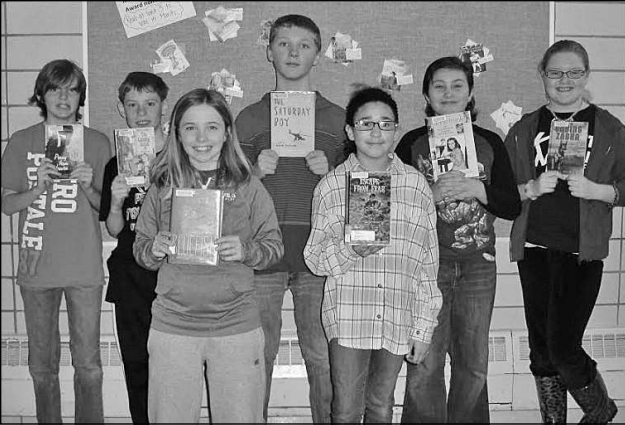

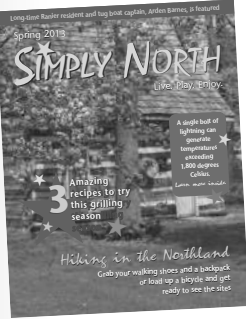

A regular meeting of the City Council of International Falls, Minnesota, was held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on the 3rd day of March 2014 at the hour of 4:30 P.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Councilors Ek-lund, Jaksa, Kalar, and Mayor Anderson  
ABSENT: Councilor Rognestad

Mayor Anderson recognized and thanked Betty Bergstrom, Deputy Administrator, for her outstanding service as the Interim City Administrator for the past year. He also introduced and welcomed the new City Administrator, Ken Anderson, who thanked the City Council for

him being selected to the position.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve minutes of the regular city council meeting of February 18, 2014, as amended by Mayor Anderson to insert the Public Works Director's opinion that the solar power option from Silicon Energy, LLC is not a good investment for the city due to the required payback period. Motion seconded by Councilor Ek-lund and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve transfer of Lodging Tax in the amount of \$822.23 from Fund 812 to Fund 101. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to approve payment of claims from various funds of the city including checks 52657-52739 in the amount of \$162,325.80. Motion seconded by Councilor Ek-lund and carried unanimously.

Checks 97760-97775 were issued under blanket authorization in the amount of \$80,695.73.

Robin Bjorkquist, International Falls Outdoor Expo addressed the council requesting support and funding of the live radio remote for the next Expo scheduled for March 28 & 29, 2014. Motion by Councilor Kalar to approve funding the radio remote program for this event at a cost of \$300 from Fund 809. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Ek-lund to approve the consent agenda as follows:

- 1..Approve/allow necessary expenses for Mayor and/or Councilors to attend the CGMC Legislative Action Day on March 5, 2014 in St. Paul, MN
- 2..Approve/allow necessary expenses for Mayor and/or Councilors to attend the Transportation Alliance Transportation Day at the Capitol lobbying session, March 13, 2014 in St. Paul, MN
- 3..Approve/allow necessary expenses for Mayor Anderson to attend the 2014 Minnesota Mayors Association Annual Conference April 25-26 in Fergus Falls, MN

Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.  
Jenny Greenlaugh addressed the council regarding the dragon boat race event. She reported it was an opportunity to showcase the communities and the underutilized waterfront areas. In the past there were 185 paddlers; conservatively over 1,500 spectators; and many arts, crafts, and food vendors. She said the dragon boat races were an opportunity to increase tourism, build team spirit, and create a positive sense of community. Mayor Anderson indicated the City of International Falls will be involved.

Motion by Councilor Ek-lund to accept the letter of resignation from Part-time Patrol Officer Kyle Morrison effective immediately and authorize letter of appreciation for his service. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar and carried unanimously.  
Motion by Councilor Ek-lund to accept the letter of retirement from Firefighter Engineer Richard Houglum effective May 31, 2014 and authorize letter of appreciation for his 25 plus years of service. The council noted his sense of humor will

be missed and very much appreciated his dedication and job knowledge. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Jaksa to adopt Resolution #08-14 approving the application and permit for a 1 to 4 day temporary on-sale liquor license for Citizens for Backus/AB, Inc., for the event date of April 11, 2014. Motion seconded by Councilor Kalar and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Ek-lund to adopt Resolution #09-14 approving the application and permit for a 1 to 4 day temporary on-sale liquor license for the International Falls Rotary Club, for the event dates of March 14-16, 2014. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.

Motion by Councilor Ek-lund to adopt Resolution #10-14 approving the International Falls Lions Club application for exempt permit to sell raffle tickets, with the drawing to held July 4, 2014. Motion seconded by Councilor Jaksa and carried unanimously.  
A work session was scheduled by consensus for 3:30 P.M. on March 17, 2014 to review the proposed 2013 - 2015 Strategic Action Plan.

Robin Bjorkquist stated the KCCT TV channel is being worked on by a group of dedicated volunteers who are excited about the new opportunity. They are hoping to implement improvements and bring the people in the county together. She said the channel will be streamed on the web and she hopes the council sees the value in the future.  
The next regular Council meeting is Monday, March 17, 2014 at 4:30 P.M. The work session is scheduled for 3:30 P.M. on March 17, 2014 to review the proposed 2013 - 2015 Strategic Action Plan.  
The meeting was adjourned by Mayor Anderson at 5:17 P.M.
