Attorney: Lane to be charged in robbery

International Falls police arrested Jeffrey A. Lane, 25, of International Falls, just after noon Monday in connection with last week's armed robbery of Koerter's Amoco in International Falls.

Capt. Tom Lynch declined to provide more details about the arrest, saying that the investigation continues into the robbery that took place Jan. 28 when someone entered the store, 1601 Second Ave. W., produced a knife and demanded money from the cash register.

Koochiching County Attorney Jeff Naglosky told The Journal Tuesday morning that he believed Lane would be arraigned

on charges that day, when he would be made aware of his rights, hear about further court actions and hear bail conditions.

Naglosky said he had reviewed the reports and Lane would be charged with one count of first-degree aggravated robbery and one count of fifth-degree possession of a controlled substance.

Police Chief Mike Musich told the International Falls City Council Monday that an arrest had been made in the robbery through a joint effort of his department and the Koochiching County Sheriff's Office.

"The guys worked really good together and a lot of effort went into it," Musich said.
