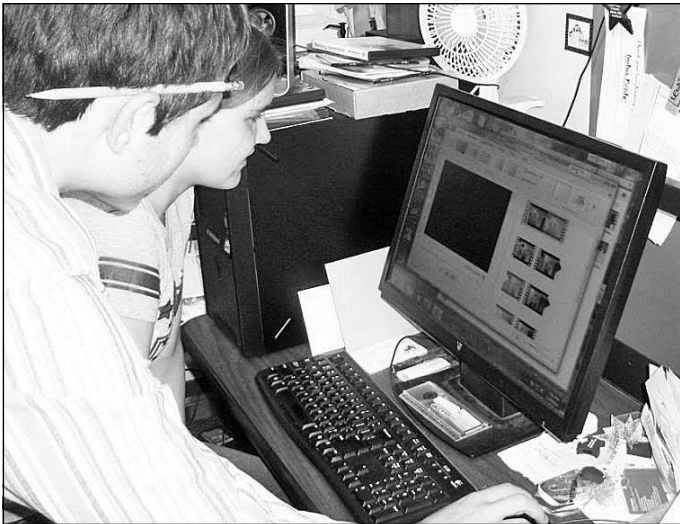

Lefse, a Scandinavian treat especially popular around the holidays, is a traditional soft Norwegian flatbread made out of potato, flour, and milk or cream and cooked on a griddle. Many

Scandinavian-Americans eat lefse primarily around Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Family members often gather to cook lefse as a group effort because the process is more enjoyable as a traditional holiday activity, and that's what happened at FHS. Over 150 students made lefse with volunteers.
