ished in under 22 minutes. Ann Bauermeister, 40, placed third in 21:10.74. Amber Hardwig, 38, came in fourth in 21:47.34. Jen Erickson, 40, finished fifth in 21:56.62.

Medals were awarded to the top-three male and female finishers in seven age categories.

The Bass Dash 5K, which has had more than 100 finishers in all three years the run/walk has been in existence, had 37 males and 72 females complete this year's race.
