Detour on Highway 6

Motorists on Minnesota Highway 6 north of Deer River and south of Highway 286 will encounter a detour for the next two weeks as crews make an emergency culvert repair, according to the Minnesota Department of Transportation. The detour, which started Wednesday, from the north will follow Highway 286 east to Marcell, then south on Highway 38. Then take County Road 48 south to County Road 19 west. The project will make an emergency culvert repair, improve drainage, and reduce flooding. Motorists should always drive with caution, slow down in work zones and never enter a road or lane blocked with barriers or cones.
