

FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT (CM)
SERVICES, AS AGENCY

The International Falls-Koochiching County Airport Commission seeks Statements of Qualifications from qualified firms to provide construction management services as an agency on the Airline Terminal Remodel and Expansion project.

The selected Construction Management firm shall be prohibited from submitting a bid as a general contractor during the competitive bidding process for any terminal-related project where construction management services were provided.

Anticipated services to be provided from the selected firm are as follows:

- Provide pre-construction services during the design phase of the project or phases of the project, including value engineering reviews, constructability reviews, and other services as required.
- Provide construction administration services during construction of the project or phases of the project, including construction observation, administration, and closeout.

The Construction Management firm will be selected based on qualifications. Do not submit any cost information. A contract agreement will be developed after the firm has been selected, which will identify the scope of services and fee related to the scope.

Statements of Qualifications should be received by the commission no later than close of business November 19, 2014, to allow adequate time for review. At least eight (8) copies of each printed item should be provided. Limit the size of the submittal to 20 pages of written documentation. Minimum requirements for the submission include:

2. Similar project experience
3. Resumes of key personnel who will be assigned to and work on this project
4. References

The commission will review all submitted Statements of Qualifications and will make a determination on a successful candidate on or before December 23, 2014. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all Statements of Qualifications.

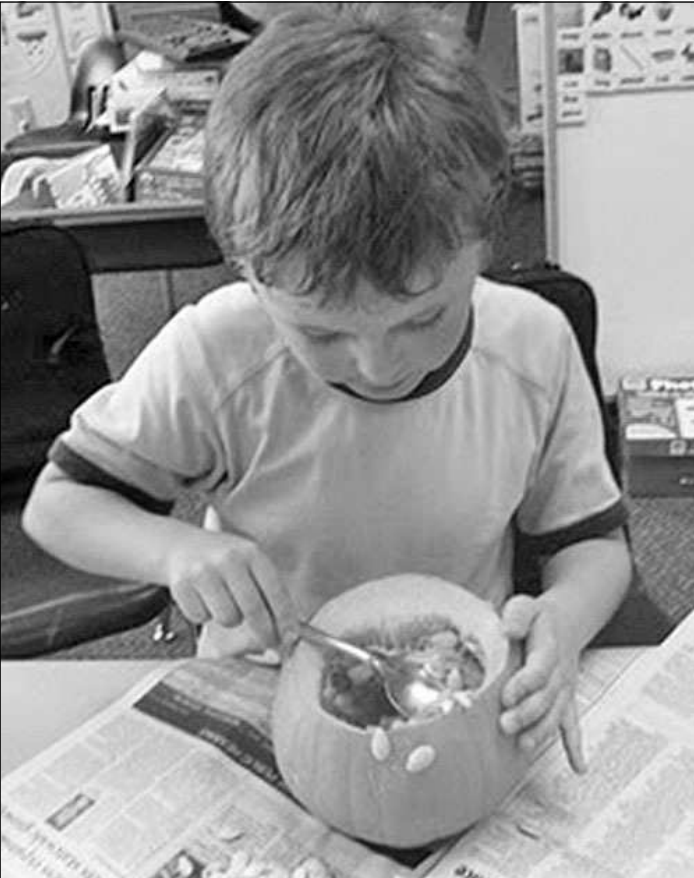

Pumpkin math at Indus School

INDUS SCHOOL REPORT

Indus School first graders explored pumpkins for pumpkin math in October, estimating the weight, length of the stem, and number of seeds in the pumpkins.

Children tested them to see if they would float or sink in water. They measured the pumpkins around the middle, measured the stem, and counted the ribs on their pumpkins.

Students weighed the pumpkins to see if their estimates were close and then sorted out and counted seeds in groups of 10. Some of the pumpkins had over
