Koochiching County 4-H fair results

4-H STAFF REPORT

4-H at Minnesota county fairs are not just fun annual events. Every summer, tens of thousands of 4-H youth participate in county fairs to showcase the knowledge and skills they've gained throughout the year, and to continue their learning experiences.

4-H youth spend months working on projects designed to equip them with essential life skills such as problem solving, decision making, project management, communications and public speaking. 4-Hers then share their accomplishments and educate the public about their subject at their local county fair. They also lead visitors on tours of the 4-H buildings and barns, and conduct workshops and hands-on demonstrations for the public. 4-Hers who demonstrate the highest achievements are then selected to participate in 4-H at the Minnesota State Fair.

Horse Show Results
This year's 4-H State Qualifying Horse show took place on July 8. There were 10 riders registered in Senior, Junior, Novice, and Cloverbud level classes. Throughout the show, the judge assigns a ribbon placing, and Blue Ribbon rankings translate into points.
