## Restaurant opens for the summer

The Shorelunch Cafe, at 1525 Second Avenue West, has reopened for the season.

Owner Chantill Roberts said the restaurant will be open from 6 a.m. to 3 or 4 p.m., depending on how busy the cafe is in the afternoon. She reopened the restaurant for the season on Thursday, she said, after arriving in town from the state of Virginia, where she lives with her husband.

So far, business has been good, she said, and she's been really happy with the start to the season.

Roberts is originally from the area, she said, and loves returning to International Falls for the summer and working at the restaurant. She has worked there since 1998, when her mother bought it, she said. Two years ago she purchased it from her mother, she said, and has been running it on a seasonal basis for the past two years.

"I'm really very excited for the summer," Roberts

said. "I consider my customers to be my people, I wait for them every year, and I've been here since 1998. I've really developed some good relationships and friendships over the years."

Her husband serves in the military and is stationed in Washington D.C., and is currently deployed in Iraq, Roberts said. Because of her family's close connection with the military, she said any customer who shows their military ID gets a discount at the restaurant.

The restaurant serves breakfast all day and their wild rice soup is a popular dish, along with the hash-brown omelette and wall-eye, Roberts said. All the food, from the soups and sauces to the coleslaw and fries, are handmade from scratch, she said, with many of the recipes passed down from her mother.

"I think the food is wonderful, and our staff is friendly, which is really our focus," Roberts said. "I want everyone to have a good experience when they come here."
