Arrowhead Library System said the program tour was planned around the Oct. 16-17 school break with the “idea in mind that some libraries would like to provide programming during the day for area students.”

The program will be about one hour long and will allow kids of all ages to get creative and explore cartooning concepts, Magnusson said.

This family program is designed for students in kindergarten through

sixth grade. However, organizers say younger kids will enjoy it with the help of a parent or grandparent while older participants will enjoy the opportunity to learn basic drawing and get tips for practicing and completing their comic strip.

The program is sponsored by Arrowhead Library System and was funded in part or in whole with funds from Minnesota’s Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund.
