The County Board approved the January 21st meeting agenda; approved the minutes from the January 14, 2014 meeting; received notice on the hire of Shawn Pritchard as Heavy Equipment Operator; approved payment of the Courthouse claims in the amount of \$133,398.72, the Highway claims in the amount of \$71,236.76, the Public Health claims in the amount of \$13,881.89 and Community Service Department claims as presented.

2014/01-29 Motion by McBride, seconded by Adee to approve a resolution as sponsor for the Polar Poles Ski Club in the Grant in Aid Program for the Tilson Cross Country Ski Trail for equipment purchase. Voting yes: Ecklund, McBride, Skoe, Adee, Pavleck. Motion carried.
