Hands-on and outdoors

If spring and summer ever arrive to Borderland, local children will now be educated on outdoors safety and other activities, thanks to an outdoor education program.

Students headed to Falls Country Club Wednesday and Thursday, and heard presentations from a variety of outdoors organizations, including Voyageurs National Park, Molpus Land Management, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, and more.

VNP staff along with U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary

members educated students on proper boat safety, and the different safety items every boat should have. They also got a tutorial on the different types of life vests, as well as how to throw a flotation device to someone in the water.

A DNR forester was on hand to teach kids how to be safe and prevent fires in the outdoors. They learned about the fire triangle, a de-

vice to remember the three things fire needs to exist: oxygen, heat, and fuel. If one of the needs is removed, then a fire can't start or spread.

Koochiching County foresters showed students how to properly use a compass, in case they get lost out in the woods. They also demonstrated how to count off their paces in order to determine distance.
