STOCKED TO THE GILLS

More than 1,500 rainbow trout have been stocked at the Rainy Lake Sportfishing Club's Rod Smith Memorial Kids Fishing Pond. RLSC volunteers added the fish to the pond, located on the east end of County Road 138, May 20. The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources Fisheries staff last week netted unwanted fish from the pond in an effort to improve the trout's survival. The DNR nets captured more than 30 northern pike, which eat a lot of trout, and more than 3,000 bullheads, considered a nuisance.

NATURE'S LESSONS

Falls High School science department partnered with Voyageurs National Park for this year's seventh grade science field day May 23 at the Rainy Lake Visitor Center. Staff at the center coordinated science-centered activities for the day. Students moved through six learning stations involving water quality analysis, canoeing, ethno-botanical garden, fishing, tree identification using dichotomous keys and a nature hike on the Oberholtzer Trail. "Students not only learned a great deal of hands-on field science but also caught a bunch of really nice fish," reported FHS science instructor
