

Winter severity index is at 152


in Borderland had an index of 171 on this date, Petersen recalled.

The winter severity index for the International Falls area was 152 on Wednesday, reports Larry Petersen, Minnesota Department of Natural Resources area wildlife manager in International Falls.

The WSI was 108 last year at this date, and 40 two years ago, he reports.

The average WSI for this date is about 100. The harshest winter in the mid 1990s

The snow depth is around 24-30 inches in the International Falls vicinity. The deeper snow can be found south and east of the Falls.

The winter severity index

is a standardized number the DNR uses when considering impacts of the winter on deer. It is calculated using temperature and snow depth in the period from Nov. 1 through April 30 or whenever winter ends. Every day the daily low temperature is zero or below is one point, and every day the snow depth is 15 inches or deeper in an open aspen woods is one point. The points are added each week until winter ends.
