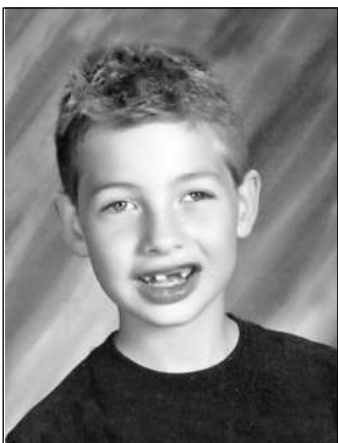

hunting and fishing.

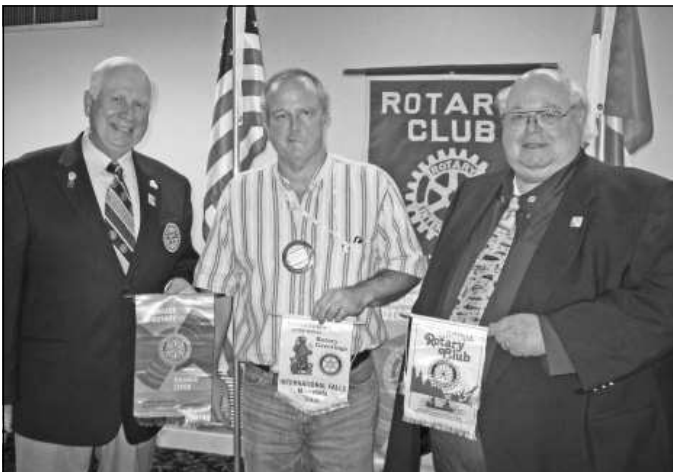
He will be remembered by his family and friends in Big Falls and Arizona.
