ASK A TROOPER

Changing your driver’s license address

Q: How long does a person have to change their driver’s license address?

A: It depends on the circumstance. I will name off some situations.

■ If you’re already living in Minnesota and move to a new address in the state, the law requires that you apply for a new driver’s license within 30 days of changing your address.

■ If you have a valid driver’s license or instruction permit from another state, you have 60 days after becoming a Minnesota resident to obtain your Minnesota license or permit.

■ If you have a valid “commercial driver’s license” (CDL) from another state, you have 30 days to obtain your Minnesota license after moving here.

■ You do not need a Minnesota license if you work for the United States Armed Forces or are a family member of someone in the Armed Forces stationed in Minnesota, and hold a valid out-of-state driver’s license.

■ If you are on active duty with the U.S. armed forces and have a valid Min-

nesota driver’s license, you are not required to renew your license until you are discharged, regardless of your length of service. This law also applies to the spouses of those on active duty, if the spouse does not reside in Minnesota during the active duty period.
