Tuesday, May 13, at 6 p.m., Jungle Portraits, Photography with Frederick Blanch, will be at the library. Breathtaking and beautiful: the photography of exotic birds, flowers, and scenes from around the world plus hints on turning your photos into artistic masterpieces.

Questions are encouraged during a fascinating program

exploring the capture of nature with a camera, presented by writer/photographer, Frederick Blanch. Frederick will take you through his exotic photographs from Ecuadorian sword-billed hummingbirds to colorful Puerto Rican Palms, to the tranquil setting of a Japanese reflecting garden. His collection represents many years of travel, through gardens, prairies, jungles, cloud forests and mountain regions throughout the world.

Join us as Frederick explains how his photographs are refined by incorporating the distinctive Jungle Portrait texture and, in some, inherent, but obscure colors are enhanced. The final picture is imprinted on high quality, white artist's canvas by the giclée method and “gallery-wrapped” or traditionally framed.
