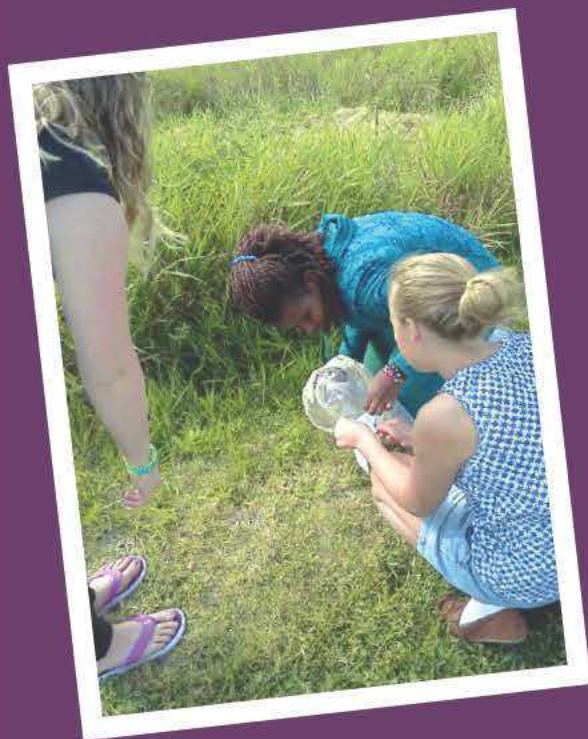
Get Enrolled Today to Catch the Bronco Spirit!

- > Concurrent enrollment college courses in partnership with Rainy River Community College and Mesabi Range College

 - **All concurrent enrollment course classes are weighted**
 - Flexible Schedule
 - Tuition, fees, and textbooks funded by the state of Minnesota
 - Students are able to schedule a combination of concurrent enrollment courses and high school courses without class times conflicting
 - Parents can continue to track homework, grades, and attendance on Skyward system
 - Parents can speak directly to teachers regarding their child
