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I met with the complainant at Greenwood City Hall regarding a property-related complaint. The complainant advised that she works for the victim/property owner and was meeting with me at the victim's request.

The victim resides at [REDACTED] Lowell Avenue and owns several properties within the city limits of Greenwood. One of the properties involved in this matter is located near the intersection of Mathis Road and Lowell Avenue.

According to the complainant, [REDACTED] a candidate for Mayor of the City of Greenwood, previously asked the victim for permission to place a political campaign sign on the victim's property. The victim granted [REDACTED] permission to do so.

At some point thereafter, a political campaign sign supporting [REDACTED], who is also a candidate for Mayor of the City of Greenwood, appeared on the same property. According to the complainant, the victim had not given [REDACTED] or anyone associated with his campaign permission to place a campaign sign on the property. The victim subsequently removed the [REDACTED] campaign sign from his property.

The complainant stated that over the next several days, [REDACTED] campaign signs continued to appear on the property. Each time, the victim removed the signs because he owned the property and had not authorized their placement.

The complainant further reported that a trail camera was subsequently attached to a fence located on the victim's property. Photographs from the trail camera depicted the victim removing campaign signs from his property. According to information provided to me, [REDACTED] later posted photographs of the victim on social media and alleged that the victim was stealing his campaign signs.

The complainant contacted [REDACTED] through social media and advised him that the signs had not been stolen. The complainant explained that the signs had been removed because they were placed on private property without the property owner's permission. The complainant further advised [REDACTED] that the signs had been placed against the fence and were available for him to retrieve. According to the social media correspondence provided to me, [REDACTED] responded that the signs could be thrown away.

I was provided with copies of the relevant social media posts and photographs, including photographs reportedly taken by the trail camera that had been attached to the fence.

I was also provided with another photograph depicting an individual identified in the social media post as [REDACTED] from Lodge Grounds. The post included the statement, "they stole another one." I was advised that [REDACTED] has a history of walking along Mathis Road and picking up litter.

The photograph depicting [REDACTED] appears to have been taken by a trail camera positioned on the inside of a fence surrounding the Lodge Grounds property. According to information provided by the victim and Greenwood County GIS records, Parcel ID [REDACTED] is owned by the victim. Based upon the location depicted in the photograph and the available property information, the camera appears to have been positioned on property owned by the victim.

As a result of these incidents and the victim's concerns regarding unauthorized entry onto and/or placement of equipment on his private property, the victim requested that [REDACTED] be formally trespassed from the following properties:

Trespass Notice forms will be completed for the above-listed properties and served upon █████. Copies of the applicable Greenwood County GIS records identifying the properties and parcel numbers will be included with the trespass documentation.

At this time, this report is intended to document the complaint, the information and evidence provided, the property owner's request, and the issuance of the trespass notices.

All documentation and materials provided to me by the complainant, including copies of the social media posts, photographs, and other supporting documentation, were placed in a secure file in my office for safekeeping and preservation in the event the materials are needed for future reference or inquiry.
