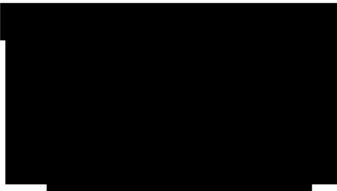

Primary Narrative By Darryl Reed, 07/28/26 17:19

On 7/28/2026, I, Deputy Reed, responded to ■■■ Hwy 76 W in the county of Laurens, South Carolina, to speak with ■■■ in reference to a suspicious bundle he found on his property.

■■■ described a bundle with tape on both ends. The fire department and multiple units responded to the area for a possible explosive device. While I was en route, Lt. Hampton advised me it was a firework bundle. I activated my BWC (Body Worn Camera) upon arrival.

I made contact with ■■■. He said he was mowing his grass and noticed the bundle in the front yard. He stated he had a current lawsuit with Greenwood County and wanted the incident documented and forwarded to SLED. I acknowledged I would document the incident.

■■■ said he heard a loud noise last night around 0130 hours but was not sure what it was. I was advised he did not see anything out of the ordinary last night or today. He showed me the bundle, which contained eight tubes with duct tape around both ends. The tubes were empty upon observation.

I gathered his information for report submission.
