Pursuant to the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, the Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, the Clean Streams Law, and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, notice is hereby given that Neiswonger Construction, Inc., 17592 Route 322, Strattanville, PA 16258 has made application to the Bureau of District Mining Operations, 286 Industrial Park Road, Ebensburg, PA 15931-4119, to revise existing Large Noncoal Surface Mine Permit #3220301, known as the Sewickley Mine. The purpose of the revision is to delete 9.9 acres from the extreme eastern end of the permit that have not been affected and add 9.9 acres to the southwestern corner of the current permit to allow for mining in the added area. The 9.9 acre adjustments are both on the property of FLC Properties, LLC.

The 339.0 acre permit is located in Young Township, Indiana County, as shown on the U.S.G.S. 7 1/2' McIntyre and Avonmore quadrangle maps, 15.5 inches north and 1.3 inches west of the bottom right hand corner of the printed area of the Avonmore quadrangle map, approximately 1.7 miles southwest of West Lebanon, on the north and south sides of SR 3023. Neiswonger Construction, Inc. will continue to surface mine limestone, conduct blasting activities, and discharge treated water to unnamed tributaries to Whisky Run, Whisky Run, and Nesbit Run.

The receiving streams have Chapter 93 classifications of Cold Water Fisheries. There is topographic drainage to Harpers Run from the existing permit area, but there will be no discharge of treated water to Harpers Run as a result of this boundary correction. The application, plans, and other data concerning this revision have been placed on file for public review at the above listed office of the Bureau of District Mining Operations. Anyone wishing to submit comments or requests for an informal conference concerning this application for revision should write to the above listed Bureau of District Mining Operations address within thirty (30) days of the final publication of this notice stating his or her name, address, telephone number, and the nature of their comment. Indiana Borough is soliciting sealed proposals from qualified contractors for paving and site improvement work at the Indiana Borough Municipal Building. The project involves milling and resurfacing of the parking lot, limited base reconstruction, sidewalk removal and replacement, and installation of new asphalt curb.
The successful contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary to complete the following work:

- Parking Lot Milling and Paving
 - Mill 1 1/2" (inch) of existing asphalt over an area of approximately 30,000 square feet.
 - Place and compact 1 1/2" of new bituminous wearing course (Superpave or PennDOT approved equivalent).
 - All edges shall be neatly milled and properly sealed.
- Base Reconstruction Area
 - At a designated section approximately 32 feet by 53 feet (1,696 square feet), remove existing pavement as needed.
 - Install 4" asphalt base course and 2" wearing course.
 - Compact and finish to match surrounding grades.
- Sidewalk Removal and Replacement
 - Remove existing sidewalks at and along 9th Street on the building side, replace with asphalt pavement consisting of 4" base course and 2" top course, matching adjacent surfaces and grades.
- Asphalt Curb Installation
 - Install new asphalt curb along the courthouse side of the parking area per Borough specifications.
 - Curb to be machine-extruded or hand-formed to match existing configurations.
- General Requirements
 - Contractor shall provide all necessary traffic control and site cleanup upon project completion.

TO FINESSE OR
TO ESTABLISH?

George Orwell claimed, "One does not establish a dictatorship in order to safeguard a revolution; one makes a revolution in order to establish a dictatorship."

At the bridge table, one sometimes establishes a winner in order to safeguard a contract — as in this deceptive deal. South reaches four hearts. What should he do after West leads the diamond king?

North's three-diamond jump-cue-bid below three of partner's suit was a Mixed Raise. It showed four-card heart support, 7-9 high-card points and nine losers: a hand too good for a pre-emptive jump-raise to three hearts and too weak for a game-invitational two-diamond cue-bid raise.

The original South won with his diamond ace, drew trumps and played a spade to dummy's

10. East won with his jack and returned a diamond. Declarer ruffed and took a second failing spade finesse. Later, he lost two club tricks to go down one.

Agreed, it was unlucky that all four key cards were offside, but South could have survived. After drawing trumps, declarer should have attacked clubs. West would have won with his queen and shifted to a spade, but South would have taken a finesse. East would have won and led back a diamond. South would have ruffed and played the club king.

West could have won this trick or the next and led a spade, but declarer would have won with dummy's ace and discarded dummy's last spade on his fourth club. Then, finally, South would have ruffed his third spade. He would have taken one spade, five hearts, one diamond, two clubs and that spade ruff on the board.
