Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations, the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act as amended, and the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act as amended, notice is hereby given that Rosebud Mining Company, 301 Market Street, Kittanning, PA 16201, has made application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to add an additional 53.0 acres to the existing permit CRD# 32850701 and related NPDES Permit #PA0213683 known as Clymer Refuse Disposal Site. The additional area will include 26.0 acres of additional disposal area and 27.0 acres of support area. Included in this 53.0 acres is acreage currently permitted under the adjacent Clymer Tipple Permit CMAP# 32841602.

The coal refuse operation consists of consists of 90.5 acres for coal refuse disposal and 80.9 acres for the support area for a total of 171.4 acres; and is located in Cheryhill Township, Indiana County at 110 Treese Lane, Clymer, PA 15728. The additional acreage begins at the point where the existing haul road crosses over Dixon Run and follows the existing permit limit east approximately 1450 feet following the unnamed tributary where it turns south and continues to follow the existing permit limit approximately 1000 feet where it intersects the Tipple permit limit. The expansion area then follows the tipple permit limit southeast for 200 feet and follows the Tipple and refuse permit limits an additional 450 feet where it turns west and extends 1300 feet where it turns north and extends 380 feet to where it intersects the Tipple permit area again and follows the existing permit limit in a northern direction for 630 feet turns slightly north east for 320 feet where it intersects with Treese Road it then follows Treese road to the point of beginning described above.

There are seven NPDES outfalls for this operation. Outfall 006 (40° 41' 01", 79° 00' 21") and Outfall 009 (40° 41' 04", 79° 00' 19") discharge treated surface runoff to Tributary 44301 to Dixon Run. Outfall 007 (40° 41' 04", 78° 59' 59"), Outfall 008 (40° 41' 11", 78° 59' 52") and Outfall 011 (40° 41' 14", 78° 59' 54") discharge treated surface runoff to an Unnamed Tributary (UNT #1) to Buck Run. Outfall 010 (40° 41' 20", 79° 00' 33") and Outfall 012 (40° 41' 20", 79° 00' 33") discharge treated surface runoff to Dixon Run. All of the described areas can be found on the Clymer and Commodore USGS, 7.5 minute series topographic maps.

Included in the permit is a request to vacate approximately 832 feet of Treese Road to allow the construction of the proposed disposal area and needed support area facilities. The application also includes variance requests for six unnamed tributaries. Construction of the Clymer Refuse Disposal Expansion Area will directly impact approximately 1,422 l.f. of biologically variable stream and 844 l.f. of intermittent stream, including 2,126 l.f. of direct impacts and 140 l.f. of indirect impacts to the portions of Streams 44298A, 44298B and 44298C that fall outside of the LOD.

KEEP IT SIMPLE, SENSIBLE DECLARER

Sam Levenson, a humorist and author who died in 1980, said, "It's so simple to be wise. Just think of something stupid to say, then say the opposite."

That seems to recommend an unnecessary step. Why not just think of something wise?

Let's try to find the simple line to make six hearts in today's deal after West leads the spade queen to South's ace. What should declarer do?

Note North's two-heart rebid. This is preferable to one no-trump with no spade stopper. Those three strong hearts will usually be as good as four low. Then South immediately wonders about a slam, but is nervous about two immediate club losers. He rebids two spades, knowing his partner will treat this as a game-try. And when North continues with two no-

trump, guaranteeing at least one club stopper, South jumps to what he hopes he can make.

Declarer has two losers, one in each black suit. He might play to establish dummy's diamond suit, but that would fail here. The much simpler line is to gain an extra trick by ruffing a loser in the shorter trump hand.

At trick two, South leads a club. Let's suppose East takes dummy's queen with his ace and returns his second spade. Declarer wins with his king, plays a club to dummy's king, takes the heart ace, leads the heart seven to his queen, and cashes the club jack, discarding dummy's remaining spade. Then South ruffs his last spade with dummy's heart king, returns to his hand with a diamond, draws trumps, and claims 12 tricks: two spades, five hearts, two diamonds, two clubs and that spade ruff.
