ONE COMBINATION, BUT FOUR SUITS

W. Somerset Maugham said, "It's asking a great deal that things should appeal to your reason as well as to your sense of the aesthetic."

Bridge deals are sometimes aesthetic, but the right answer to all of them can usually be found by applying reason. In today's deal, what is the reasonable approach for South in four hearts after West leads the club queen?

North used a transfer bid followed by a jump to three no-trump to show the values for game with exactly five hearts and, probably, a balanced hand. Here, South would have done best to pass, but it is hard to quibble with opting for the eight-card major-suit fit. (Note that the transfer did its job. Four hearts by North goes down if East leads the spade queen.)
 Taken in isolation, declarer

would finesse in hearts. But here a heart finesse ought to be fatal. East would win with his queen and should shift to the spade queen.

Not wanting a spade lead through his king, declarer should try to keep East off the lead. South wins the first trick and cashes dummy's two top hearts. When the queen does not drop, he turns to the diamonds. Yes, East ruffs the fourth round, but declarer has discarded one of dummy's spades, so loses only one heart and two spades.

Note that if West has queen-third of hearts, South's play costs only an overtrick. And if East can ruff the second or third diamond, declarer is still all right when East either does not switch to spades or holds the spade ace.

Always take the full deal into account.

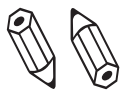
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 5, 2026, at 7 p.m. at 1492 Route 240 Hwy, Commodore, Pennsylvania, the Supervisors of Green Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, will act on an Ordinance (of which this notice is the summary prepared by the Borough Solicitor) includes the following:

- The right, but not the mandate, the owners of houses, buildings or other structures in the Township that will use water for human consumption and which about the public water supply system of Indiana County Municipal Services Authority (the "Authority") or are located within 150 feet of any portion of Authority's the current public water system or any extensions thereof, to connect to the Authority's public water system.
- The mandate that the owners of houses, buildings or other structures in the Township that about the public water supply system of the Authority or are located within 150 feet of any portion of Authority's the current public water system or any extensions thereof pay any tap fee and the monthly development fees imposed by the Authority.
- The requirement for the Authority to notify the owner, lessee or occupier of each structure covered hereunder, in writing, of the right to connect to said public water system, within 90 days after receipt of such notice. Any owner, lessee or occupier of a structure who does not connect to the public water system within such 90 day period, shall commence paying the development fee as of the end of such 90 day period.
- Making it unlawful for any person, entity, firm or corporation connected to the public water system to connect to or permit the connection by any other person, firm or corporation of any other source of water supply for human consumption, to the public water system. No cross connecting with private water supplies are permitted.
- Providing the prerequisites and conditions necessary to connect to the public water system.
- Providing that all connections between the buildings and the public water system shall be done in accordance with the specifications, plans and procedures established by the Authority in its rules and regulations, as the same may be from time to time amended or published, copies of which, upon adoption, shall be maintained on file with the Township.
- Authorizing the Authority to file a municipal claim or lien against any premises as provided by law for violation of the Ordinance.
- Providing that if one or more mobile homes, located in a mobile home park, are subject of to the provisions this Ordinance, all mobile homes in such mobile home park are subject to the Ordinance regardless of whether or not located within 150 feet of the public water system of the Authority.
- Providing that the Township directs and authorizes the Authority to install, maintain, replace, flow-test, relocate, if necessary, and otherwise service fire hydrants within the Township on the Authority's water system, and agrees to pay the Authority the associated fire hydrant fees as permitted by law, provided the Township and the Authority shall mutually agree upon the placement location of any new fire hydrant subject to any legal requirements the Authority is required to follow, and further provided that the fire hydrant fee shall not be increased without 120 days' notice to the Township.
- Providing the legislative intent that the invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which shall be given effect without such invalid part or parts.
- Providing that all ordinances or resolutions or parts or ordinance or resolutions not in accordance with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict with this ordinance.
- Providing that should the Authority elect to expand the water system to areas of the Township presently not served, the Township shall have the right, but not the obligation, to conduct a survey of the residents and businesses in the extension area to determine if at least 50% of those to receive service are in favor of the extension to their area.
