Summary- Indiana County Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance Amendment for Large-Scale Solar and Wind Facilities.

Title
The Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance Amendment for Large-Scale Solar and Wind Facilities.

Effectiveness
Applicability

Consistent with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (MPC), the provisions of the Indiana County Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance shall serve the same purpose for all municipalities within the County that do not have an independent subdivision and land development ordinance.

Effective Date
This Ordinance shall become effective in 60 days following the date of adoption by the County Board of Commissioners.

Purpose
The basic purpose of the amendment is to regulate all land development as it pertains to the development of large scale solar or wind energy facilities in Indiana County by providing for a uniform routine for the submission of preliminary and final proposals of said land development.

Definitions
Large Scale Solar or Wind Energy Facilities – A Solar or Wind Energy Facility consisting of 2 acres or more proposed for the construction of the Energy Facility, including all accessory buildings.

Solar Energy Facility – An area of land used for a solar collection system principally to capture solar energy, convert it to electrical energy or thermal power and supply electrical or thermal power primarily for off-site use.

Wind Energy Facility – An electric generating facility, whose main purpose is to supply electricity, consisting of one or more Wind Turbines and other accessory structures and buildings, including substations, meteorological towers, electrical infrastructure, transmission lines and other appurtenant structures and facilities.

Decommissioning
Decommissioning of Solar Energy Facilities

Upon the permanent cessation or abandonment of a Solar Energy Facility (SEF), the Land Owner, Lessor, Lessee, Operator, Developer, or Facility Owner shall immediately notify Indiana County. If an SEF is determined to have reached the end of its useful life or has been abandoned, the Facility Owner, Developer, Operator, and, ultimately, the Land Owner, Lessor, and Lessee shall be jointly and severally responsible for decommissioning the facility, at their expense, within eighteen (18) months.

Decommissioning of Wind Energy Facilities

Upon the end of the useful life of a Wind Energy Facility (WEF) or any individual Wind Turbine, the Developer, Facility Owner, and Operator shall be primarily responsible for completing decommissioning within twelve (12) months at their expense; however, the Land Owner, Lessor, Lessee, Developer, Facility Owner, and Operator shall ultimately be jointly and severally liable for such decommissioning. n.

Management
Management of this Ordinance is the responsibility of the Indiana County Planning Commission and the ICOPD. The ICOPD staff assists the PC and provides day to day support in the execution of this Ordinance.

Fees and Bonds
A form of security including a cash deposit, surety bond, irrevocable letter of credit, cashier's check, or escrow account from a federal or Commonwealth chartered lending institution in the amount of 110% of the total proposed decommissioning costs and in a form satisfactory to the County. Under this Ordinance all individuals or entities, including the land owner, developer, operator, lessor, lessee, or any other such individual, group, or entity responsible for the permitting, construction, operation, or ownership of a Solar or Wind Energy Facility shall be responsible provide the above referenced financial security required under this Ordinance and shall ultimately be jointly and severally liable for all financial obligations related to all costs associated with the construction, operation, development, leasing, and decommissioning costs.

Enforcement Remedies, Violations and Penalties
Enforcement Authority

The Indiana County Planning Commission and the ICOPD shall have the duty and authority to enforce the provisions of the Ordinance, as specified or implied therein. Enforcement under the Indiana County Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.
