Title V Operating Permit Significant Modification

In accordance with 25 Pa. Code §§ 127.521 and 127.541, the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) intends to issue a Significant Modification to the Title V Operating Permit and renew the Title V Operating Permit for Homer City Generation L.P. Generating Station (Homer City Generation) located in Center Township, Indiana County. Homer City Generation’s representative to contact concerning this application is Mr. Gary Cline, Environmental Manager, 1750 Power Plant Road, Homer City, PA 15748-9558. His phone number is (724) 479-6255. The Title V Permit was originally issued in 2004. The permit was amended, modified, and renewed several times since the original Title V issuance. The current Significant Modification and Permit Renewal is required to memorialize the facility’s decision to cease electrical generation with the coal fired boilers as of June 30, 2023, remove the sources no longer in operation, and include the Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) authorized by the Department. The shutdown of boilers 1, 2, and 3 generated the following ERCs: VOC 11.3 tpy; NOx 2,031.8 tpy; PM2.5 220.1 tpy. The ERCs may be used, traded, or sold after the approved entry of the ERCs by the Department into the Pennsylvania ERC Registry System. If the company wishes to restart any of the sources, a plan approval application shall be submitted. The facility and any subsequent user of these credits shall comply with the requirements of 25 PA Code 127.206, 127.207, and 127.208, regarding ERC use and transfer requirements. This Title V Operating Permit authorizes the transfer and use of the following VOC ERCs and indicates the Department’s approval of the ERC transfer and use. Upon the issuance of this Title V Operating Permit, the ERCs are no longer subject to expiration under § 127.206(f) (relating to ERC general requirements) except as specified in § 127.206(g). In accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 127.208(2), the Department authorizes the transfer and use of the entirety of the VOC emission reduction credits (ERCs) from the following facilities to Homer City Generation LP for offset purposes referred to in Plan Approval 32-00457A, Section C- Condition #022 which requires the permittee to purchase and apply 369.035 tons per year of VOC ERCs prior to commencing operation of any source at the facility to offset the total of the net increase in potential to emit:

Copies of the application, the Department’s analysis and other documents used in the evaluation of the application are available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Department of Environmental Protection, 230 Chestnut Street, Meadville, PA 16335. Any person wishing to provide the Department of Environmental Protection with additional information that they believe should be considered prior to the issuance of this permit may submit the information to the Department at the address shown above. A 30-day comment period, from the date of this publication, will exist for the submission of comments. Each written comment must contain the following information: Name, address and telephone number of the person submitting the comments; Identification of the proposed permit (specify Permit # TV 32- 00055); and Concise statements regarding the relevancy of the information in the proposed permit or objections to issuance of the permit. A public hearing may be held, if the Department, in its discretion, decides that such a hearing is warranted based on the information received. All persons submitting comments or requesting a hearing will be notified of the decision to hold a hearing by publication in the newspaper or by the Pennsylvania Bulletin, or by telephone, where the Department determines such notification by telephone is sufficient.
