AMENDMENT TO CENTER TOWNSHIP, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NUMBER 106 (RELATING TO THE UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE)

Section 5. This Section adds a new Section 10 to Ordinance Number 106 which provides, generally, that in addition to the Uniform Construction Code, the current International Fuel Gas Code, as may be amended from time to time, shall be applicable, administered, and enforced in and by the Township
