### AN EXCEPTION TO THE NORMAL RULE

Groucho Marx said, "I never forget a face, but I'll make an exception in your case."

In yesterday's deal, declarer had to establish his side suit before drawing trumps in order to make his contract. That is typically the case, but there are always exceptions to the rules, which is one of the main reasons bridge retains its popularity.

In today's deal, South is in four spades. West leads the club king. How should declarer continue after ruffing the third round of clubs?

When North raised spades, South re-evaluated. He had 15 high-card points and three short-suit points, two for the singleton heart and one for the doubleton club. That gave a total of 18 points. Also, his excellent diamond suit was a plus value. Hence South's jump to game.

South needs to find trumps 3-2, but that still gives him three top losers: one spade and two clubs. He must establish and run his diamond suit. Here, though, if he plays on that suit first, he will unluckily fail. After cashing his diamond ace and king, he ruffs a diamond in the dummy. However, East overruffs from only two trumps and declarer loses two spade tricks.

South should start with two rounds of trumps. Then he cashes his top diamonds and ruffs a diamond. Finally, he returns to his hand with his carefully conserved heart ace and plays out winning diamonds. West may ruff whenever he pleases, but declarer still has one trump left to ruff another club.

Did you notice that dummy's heart king is a red-card herring? Discarding a diamond from hand would not help South to get home.

The additional area will include 26.0 acres of additional disposal area and 27.0 acres of support area. Included in this 53.0 acres is acreage currently permitted under the adjacent Clymer Tipple Permit CMAP# 32841602.

The coal refuse operation consists of consists of 90.5 acres for coal refuse disposal and 80.9 acres for the support area for a total of 171.4 acres; and is located in Cherryhill Township, Indiana County at 110 Treese Lane, Clymer, PA 15728. The additional acreage begins at the point where the existing haul road crosses over Dixon Run and follows the existing permit limit east approximately 1450 feet following the unnamed tributary where it turns south and continues to follow the existing permit limit approximately 1000 feet where it intersects the Tipple permit limit. The expansion area then follows the tipple permit limit southeast for 200 feet and follows the Tipple and refuse permit limits an additional 450 feet where it turns west and extends 1300 feet where it turns north and extends 380 feet to where it intersects the Tipple permit area again and follows the existing permit limit in a northern direction for 630 feet turns slightly north east for 320 feet where it intersects with Treese Road it then follows Treese road to the point of beginning described above.

There are seven NPDES outfalls for this operation. Outfall 006 (40° 41' 01", 79° 00' 21") and Outfall 009 (40° 41' 04", 79° 00' 19") discharge treated surface runoff to Tributary 44301 to Dixon Run. Outfall 007 (40° 41' 04", 78° 59' 59"), Outfall 008 (40° 41' 11", 78° 59' 52") and Outfall 011 (40° 41' 14", 78° 59' 54") discharge treated surface runoff to an Unnamed Tributary (UNT #1) to Buck Run. Outfall 010 (40° 41' 20", 79° 00' 33") and Outfall 012 (40° 41' 20", 79° 00' 33") discharge treated surface runoff to Dixon Run. All of the described areas can be found on the Clymer and Commodore USGS, 7.5 minute series topographic maps.

Included in the permit is a request to vacate approximately 832 feet of Treese Road to allow the construction of the proposed disposal area and needed support area facilities. The application also includes variance requests for six unnamed tributaries. Construction of the Clymer Refuse Disposal Expansion Area will directly impact approximately 1,422 l.f. of biologically variable stream and 844 l.f. of intermittent stream, including 2,126 l.f. of direct impacts and 140 l.f. of indirect impacts to the portions of Streams 44298A, 44298B and 44298C that fall outside of the LOD.

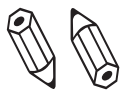

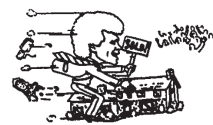
