

On January 29, 2025 at 7 pm, a special meeting of the Homer City Borough Council was held at the Homer Center Jr. Sr. High School auditorium for the purpose of deliberating a proposed ordinance to delegate administration of EMS to a County-created authority. Members present: President Joe Iezzi, Vice President Matt Black, Council members Brad Black, Cal Cecconi, and Rob Walbeck. Absent were Denise Liggett, and Cris Worcester. Present also was Arlene Wanatosky, Mayor, who arrived to the meeting at 8:25 pm. Members of several other municipalities and approximately 100 residents of Indiana County were in attendance.

A presentation entitled "Building a Better EMS System for Indiana County, the state of EMS and proposed countywide authority" was given by D. Robert Brady, II of ROBB Consulting, LLC. Introduction of the proposed ordinance was read by Attorney Ben Ried.

Open public comment regarding the proposed ordinance commenced. Several people attending presented comments and questions which were answered by the presenters.

Homer City Borough Council's meeting was then called to order by President Joe Iezzi at 8:50 pm. A motion was made by *Matt Black* to table action of this ordinance until more information is received. It was seconded by *Brad Black*. Aye votes were unanimous, and the motion carried.

The meeting was then adjourned at 8:55 pm.
