

RESOLUTION 20 -

**APPROVING OPENING
ADMINISTRATION BUILDING
FROM 7 A.M. TO 9 P.M. ON
JUNE 2, 2020, FOR PRIMARY
ELECTION**

Motion by _____, second by _____,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.4(2), the Warren County Board of Supervisors met in a meeting at 3 p.m. June 1, 2020, with less than 24 hours' notice to the public prior to the meeting to discuss opening the Administration Building from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. for the primary election to be held on June 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors must state the nature of the good cause justifying a departure from the normal notice requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has previously closed the Administration Building to comply with the Iowa Governor's prohibition on gatherings of more than 10 persons during the COVID-19 outbreak, until further notice; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Code (2020) specifically addresses issues related to an election: that the Courthouse shall remain open on election day (Iowa Code Section 49.123); that persons including reporters shall be allowed to be present at polling places (Iowa Code section 49.109(8)); and that the County Auditor shall accept ballots turned in by hand on election day (Iowa Code 53.17(1)(a)).

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby approves opening the Administration Building from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. on June 2, 2020, for the primary election, in compliance with Iowa Code Sections 49.109(8), 49.123, and 53.17(1)(a) (2020).
