Goals

- A complete city-wide trail system with no missing connections, connecting the established and future neighborhood areas to the city parks, schools, public facilities and regional trails.
- Development cost estimates for each segment of trail.
- The best location of the trails, bridge and culvert crossings, and other associated development items

Trail Priorities

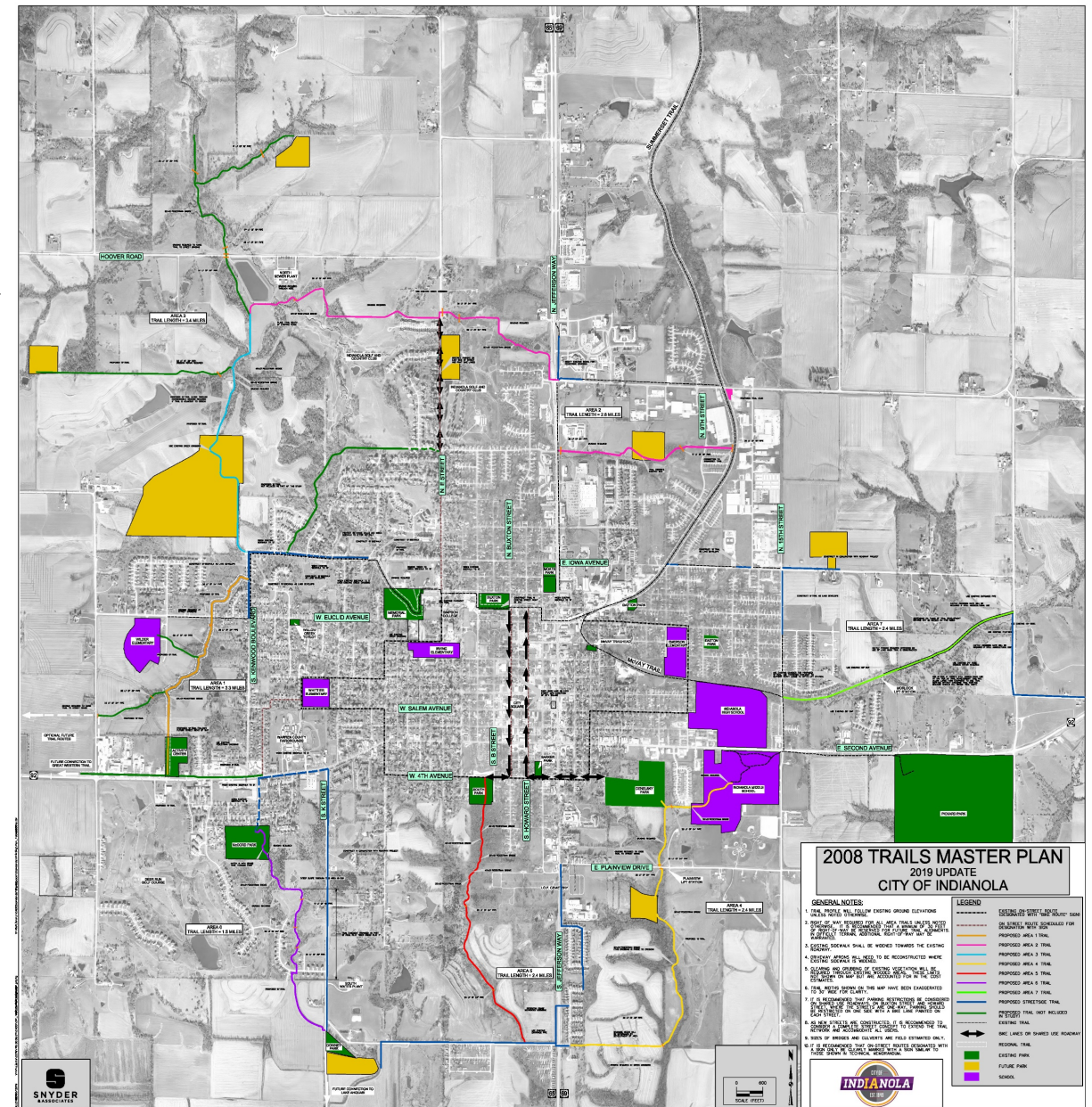
- 1) **Hillcrest Avenue - Summerset Trail to YMCA** (complete 2019)
 - Hwy 65 to 4th Ave – FY22
- 2) **Jerry Kelley Phase 2 – Memorial Park to Wilder School** (complete 2019)
 - Move Iowa Ave. section off street – FY23
- 3) **Southwest Loop – Warren County Fairgrounds to McCord and Downey Parks**
 - 1) Portion included in South K Street Paving
- 4) **Southeast Loop – Downey Park to DeNelsky Park to Middle School**
- 5) **McVay Trail – Extend to National Balloon Classic**
 - 1) Portion included in FY24 & FY25
- 6) **Hwy 65/69 to North Sewer Plant to Kenwood**
- 7) **South Central Loop – South Park to West 17th Street**
- 8) **Connect Segments along Highways 92 and 65/69**
