If you're brought aboard, you'll need to enroll in JLS 208. JLS 208 meets once a week, at a variety of times. It's a 30 minute meeting with our faculty advisor. The only coursework in the class is what you do for us. You can take it for one to three credits. One credit equates to four hours of work / week, three equals twelve. We'll send you the enrollment information after your interview.
