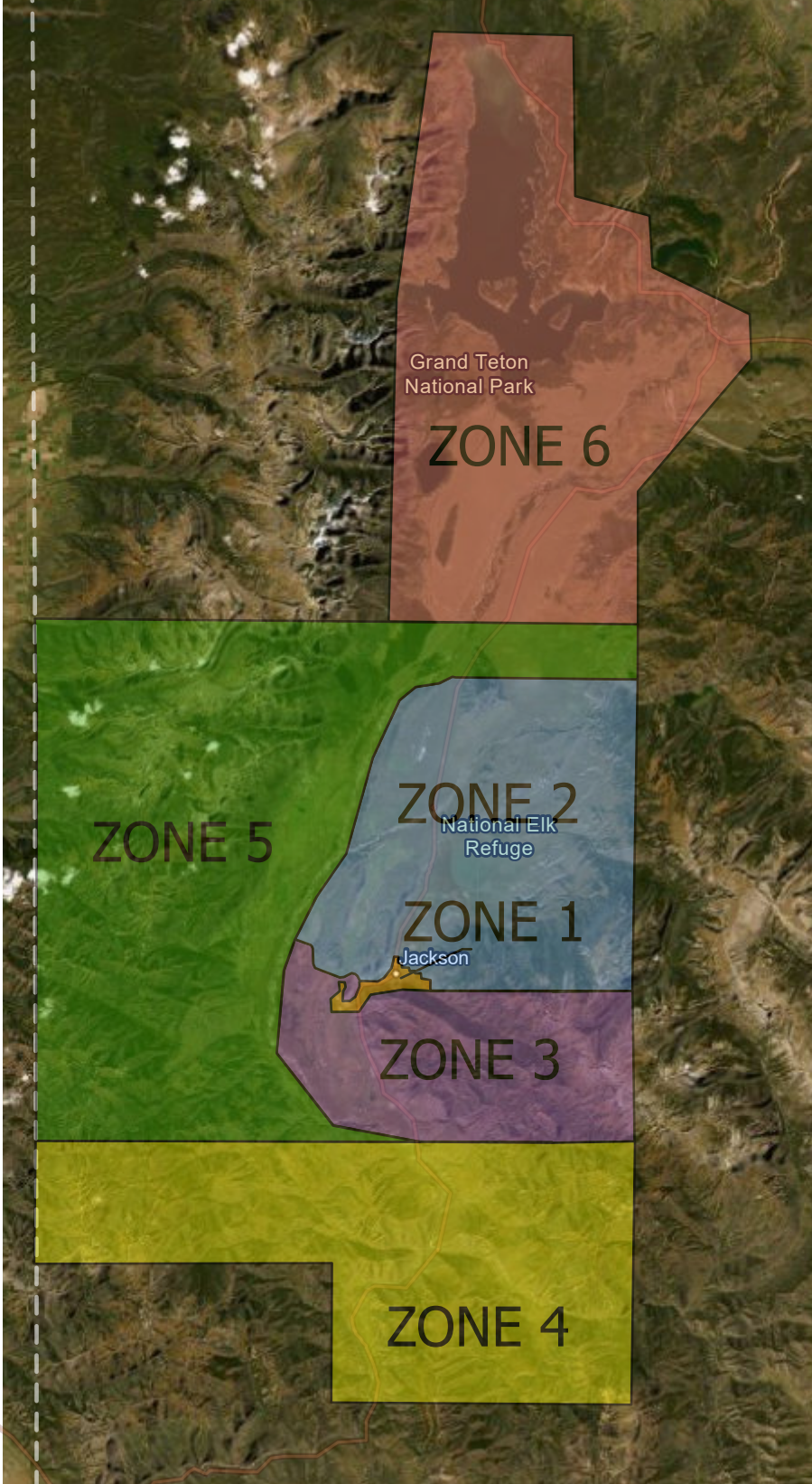




Grand Teton
National Park
