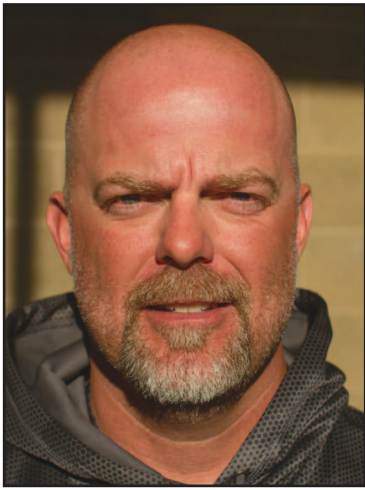
**Ronnie-Jean Bernard**
