Mabb intercepted 2 passes, returning one of them 23 yards for a touchdown in the Wolves' 23-13 win at Morristown West.

He also made 3 tackles and caught West Ridge's lone pass completion.

Wilson threw for 320 yards and 4 touchdowns at Northview Academy, hitting 16-of-23 passes and rushing for another TD as the Falcons earned a 41-8 conference win.



5-STAR PLAYER

Goodwin returned 3 kickoffs for 175 yards — one covering 67 and another going 98 yards for the go-ahead touchdown — as D-B rallied past Jefferson County 21-14. On defense, Goodwin made 5 tackles and broke up a fourth-down pass to seal the win.

In his first high school varsity start, Blevins hit 12-of-17 passes for 200 yards and 3 touchdowns to help the Cyclones roll past region rival Grainger 49-6.

Parker scored in 3 different ways during the Warriors' 67-0 win over Hancock County — a 72-yard run, a 45-yard catch and a 46-yard punt return. He rushed for a team-high 88 yards and even completed a 35-yard pass.
