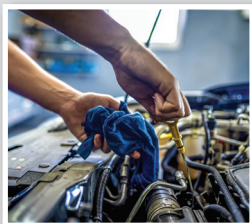
The Importance of Regular Battery Maintenance

Cold weather negatively affects car batteries by slowing down the chemical reactions that produce power, increasing internal resistance, and making the battery less able to hold a charge. These effects are compounded by thicker engine oil and increased use of electrical accessories, both of which force the battery to work harder. If a battery is old or not fully charged, cold weather can lead to a dead battery, while prolonged exposure to freezing temperatures can cause the electrolyte to freeze and irreparably damage the battery.
